Weekly Reading Tasks	Weekly Phonics Tasks
Monday- Play "Keyword Bingo" Draw a cross on your page – in each box write a keyword. Call out each word – if your child has it they can cross it off. Use previous words learned at home or words from this Pink Word List	Monday- Watch the pre-recorded lesson on Seesaw recapping our split digraphs. O-e, i-e, u-e, a-e How many split digraphs can you write? See Seesaw
Tuesday Read the book <u>Jill and the Beanstalk</u> on Epic. How is this different to our Jack and the Beanstalk story? What do we learn from the story at the end?	Tuesday- Have a go at reading some split digraphs with these online videos Video 1. Video 2 What can YOU find around the house featuring a split digraph? Write a list of the split digraph words you find.
Wednesday Do a full lesson on Reading Eggs. Don't forget to use Fast Phonics on there too.	Wednesday

	Use a trouser hanger to create our split digraphs . Say a word to your child and they have to select which split digraph hanger it is. You could make some simple letter cards and the children could make words by adding the letters to the split digraphs.
Thursday Go on a World Book Day Scavenger Hunt. See Seesaw	Thursday – Play Buried Treasure on Phonics Play. Choose Phase 5 and practice reading our four split digraphs. Decide if they are real words or fake words (pseudo words)
