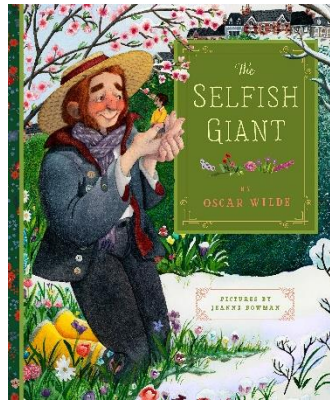


Personal, Social & Emotional Development

Knowledge & Understanding of the World

Computing

The children will create mind maps of Technology that is around us and is used regularly. The children will also create electronic illustrations using online painting apps.

Beliefs

This half term we will be learning about the Christian story David & Goliath.

Science

The children will learn about Plants, trees and seeds. We will explore what seeds and plants need to grow & remain healthy.

Geography

The children will learn how to use simple compass directions, locational language to describe routes & features on maps. They will also explore the seven continents & five oceans.

Problem Solving, Reasoning & Numeracy Maths

Our Singapore Maths units this half term will cover Addition & Subtraction, Times Tables (2, 5, 10), Multiplication & Division, as well as Length.

Creative Development

Art

The children will explore the world of 3D sculptures. We will look at the work of Jean Hans Arp, Barbara Hepworth & Nathalie Miebach to help create our own abstract sculptures using different materials.

PE

Our PE focus this half term is Gymnastics. The children will develop their balancing & body co-ordination during simple routines with & without equipment. The children will also have Forest Schools every week.

Communication, Language & Literacy

Literacy

We will be using the story 'The Selfish Giant'. The story links very closely to our own experiences during lockdown & will help the children to develop their narrative & Poetry writing skills. The pupils will use the text to reinvent the story & create their own interesting weather inspired characters.

Music

We will learn to use different instruments to compliment the song 'HO, HO, HO'
