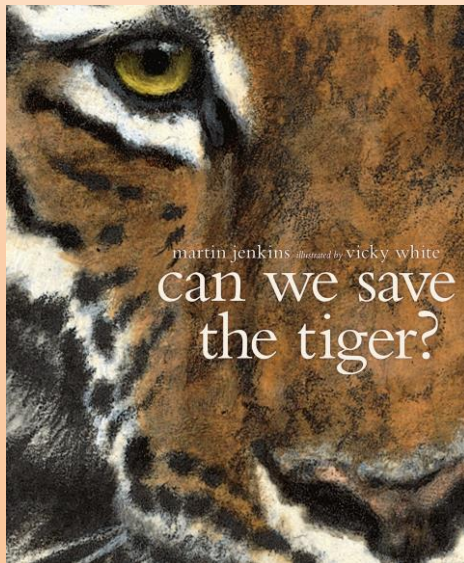


Autumn 2 - Year 6

Communication, Language & Literacy

Literacy
