#### Science

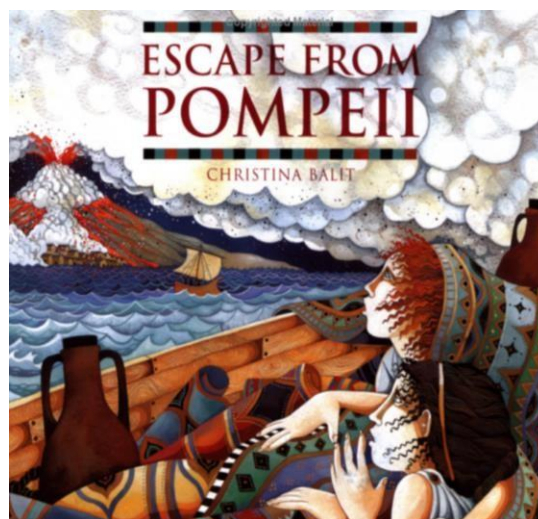
Our Science focus for this half term is Electricity. We will be learning which appliances require electricity, creating complete circuits, finding out which materials conduct electricity and using switches in a
