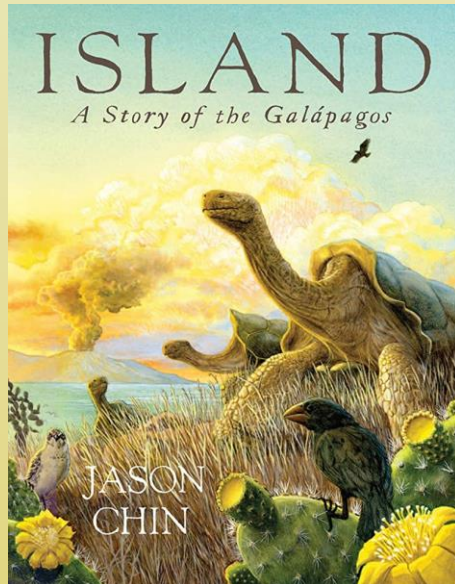


Spring 2 - Year 6
